

# Fishing on the Rursee

In order to fish on the Rursee/Obersee, a German fishing permit **AND** a fishing licence is required for foreign guests.

- 1. The German fishing permit (Fischereischein)** can be obtained from the Town Hall:  
Hengebachstr. 14, 52396 Heimbach.  
Opening hours: Monday - Friday 08.30 - 12.30 and also Tuesday 14.00 - 17.00

Guests will need to provide the following:

- a valid fishing permit from their country of origin;
- an identity card or passport;
- a (current) passport-sized photograph.

Adults (14 years of age and older) € 16.00

Children and adolescents (10 - 16 years) can obtain a youth permit for € 8.00. Guests from the age of 14 years may fish alone with an adult fishing permit (€ 16.00) provided that they can produce evidence to show that they are allowed to fish alone in their country of origin.

Please note: Children and adolescents from 10 - 16 years old using a youth permit may only fish when accompanied by a person in possession of a German fishing permit.

- 2. Fishing licences (Angelkarten)** are sold at the Tourist Information Office at the National Park entrance (in the old train station): an der Laag 4, 52396 Heimbach.  
Opening hours: daily 10.00 - 13.00 and 13.30 - 16.00 (November-March)  
09.00 - 13.00 and 13.30 - 17.00 (April to October)  
One-day fishing licence (youth): €5.50  
One-day fishing licence (adult): €11.00  
Fishing licence (adult) for three consecutive days: €21.00

Any person accompanying children or youth with a German youth permit must also buy a fishing licence if they would like to fish, too.

Otherwise, only the youth/child is required to have a fishing licence.
