

**Public information on a lower-class operating area in accordance with Section § 8a of the Incident Regulation.**

Dear guests, residents, and neighbors,

Landal GreenParks maintains a liquid gas supply storage facility at this holiday park. Such storage facilities, in which liquid gas (propane liquefied under pressure) is stored, are subject to the Hazardous Incident Regulation. Among other things, this stipulates that neighbors, residents, and vacationers must be informed about the correct behavior in the event of an accident.

This information sheet informs you about what you must do in the event of an accident. In addition, you will be informed about the potential dangers and the safety measures of the consumption storage facility.

2. We are an operating area subject to the Hazardous Incident Regulation:

as the competent supervisory authority, a corresponding notification was submitted.

3. Our main activity and core business is the management, administration, and rental of holiday parks and camping facilities in natural surroundings. We operate a liquid gas supply depot to supply the individual vacation homes and main buildings with propane gas for heating and cooking purposes. Due to the total volume of liquid gas (propane) stored, we are subject to the basic obligations of the Hazardous Incident Regulation.

4. The liquid gas is first delivered by truck. It is then temporarily stored in liquid form. It is supplied to the bungalows and central buildings in gaseous form via the pipeline network.

Propane (liquefied petroleum gas) is a colorless, odorless, highly flammable gas. Propane is heavier than air (sinks to the ground).

It is listed in No. 2.1 of Appendix 1 of the Hazardous Incident Regulation.

H280 Gas under pressure; may explode when heated



5. In the event of an incident or serious danger, the existing alarm and emergency response plan will be followed. The fire department, police, and supervisory authorities will be involved. Guests, residents, and neighbors will be informed by the relevant authorities and/or vacation park staff as necessary. Vacation park staff are familiar with the alarm plan and have been trained in its contents.

Listen for announcements made by the police or fire department over loudspeakers! Turn on the radio and find a regional station.

What is the correct way to respond in the event of an incident?

- Stay indoors, but avoid basement rooms
- Close windows and doors
- Turn off ventilation and air conditioning systems
- Do not block the telephone lines of the fire department, police, and accident site with inquiries
- Stay away from the scene of the accident and keep the roads and paths clear for the emergency services
- Pay attention to loudspeaker announcements
- Inform your neighbors and assist them if necessary
- Follow the instructions of emergency and rescue services
- Avoid open flames (candles, tea lights) at all costs and do not smoke

The “all clear” signal will be given via loudspeaker announcements or by the park management.
